Dear Eagle Scout:

I am writing to tell you of an opportunity available to Eagle Scouts in the Mobile Area Council: **The Thomas M. Lynn, Jr., Memorial Eagle Scout Scholarship.**

Thomas M. Lynn, Jr., was a member of Ashland Place United Methodist Church and of Boy Scout Troop No. 1, sponsored by the church. He was an Eagle Scout. Tommy died of a heart condition in 1984, at the age of 30. Out of their deep love for this outstanding young man, his family established the Thomas M. Lynn, Jr., Memorial Trust Fund. **The purpose of the trust fund is to award a \$1,000 college scholarship to an Eagle Scout who is a high school senior and planning to attend college this fall.** The Lynn family has appointed the Ashland Place United Methodist Church as trustee of the trust fund and a selection committee has been designated. At this point, we are ready to receive applications for this scholarship.

The Application deadline is May 1st.

In a sense, this scholarship is a celebration of those who, like yourself, have attained the rank of Eagle Scout. I encourage you to read carefully the enclosed application and to apply for The Thomas M. Lynn, Jr., Memorial Eagle Scout Scholarship. If you are not a high school senior, please let us know, and we will send you another application at the appropriate time.

Thomas M. Lynn Jr. Memorial Eagle Scout Scholarship



The Thomas M. Lynn Jr. Memorial Trust Fund grants one \$1000.00 scholarship (one-time grant, nonrenewable) to an Eagle Scout in the Mobile Area Council, Boy Scouts of America enrolled in an accredited college or university in any area of study.

The applicant must:

1. Be currently registered in the Boy Scouts of America.
2. Have been granted the Eagle Scout Award ***prior to submission of this application.***
3. Have maintained a "B" average over the past academic year.
4. Be accepted to an accredited college or university.

This application should be mailed to Ashland Place United Methodist Church, post-marked by May 1st, and be accompanied by: 1) a letter of recommendation from your current scoutmaster that states that you are currently registered in the BSA, have been granted the Eagle Scout Award, and are an active Scout, 2) a letter of recommendation from your minister, 3) transcript of high school grades covering six semesters and SAT or ACT scores, and 4) if there is a financial need, please clearly explain. This explanation should include what distinguishes your need. What is unique about your need? Discuss special family situations, e.g. a disability, one-parent family, ill health of parent, parent's loss of job, number of siblings, number of siblings in college the years you plan to attend, etc. If you do not receive this scholarship, how will you arrange to go to college? Do you have plans to pay your way through college?
