BALOO TRAINING OCTOBER 23-24,2021

PREREQUISITE: This is the newest part of the training. The online course must be taken before you arrive. Follow these steps: go to your my.scouting.org account; under Menu click on My Dashboard, My Training, Training Center, Cub Scouting, Supplemental Training, BALOO Prerequisite Training, Expanded Learning, BALOO. There are 8 modules to complete. **Be sure to print out your Certificate and bring it with you to the training.**

TRAINING: Check-in and tent setup from 5-7pm Saturday. Training starts promptly at 7:00pm; Training finishes at 9:00pm Sunday.

NECESSARY EQUIPMENT:

**Keep in mind that weather is changeable and can cool at night. We will be outside for most of the training. **

BALOO is an outdoor skills training program for a Cub Scout Leader/parent. Every Pack *must have at least one adult* who has completed this course and attends the unit's event in order to do independent Pack camping. The Outdoor WEBELOS Leader training is no longer offered, so any WEBELOS Leaders taking their den camping *must have* this training.

BALOO was revised in the summer of 2017. The changes made will improve the preparation for adults to lead the outdoor program for their pack. *Please note: the changes include prerequisite online training and an overnight camping experience.*

There is a mandatory pre-requisite course to be taken PRIOR to the overnight portion. The online course must be taken before you arrive. Follow these steps: go to your my.scouting.org account; under Menu click on My Dashboard, My Training, Training Center, Cub Scouting, Supplemental Training, BALOO Prerequisite Training, Expanded Learning, BALOO. There are 8 modules to complete. **Be sure to print out your completion certificate and bring it with you to the training.**
