Cub Scout Family Overnighter Campout Rules

2. Absolutely **NO** open flames of any kind on the grass or in canopy/tents. This includes lanterns, candles, any open flames, camp stove, small grill, or any apparatus that is not battery operated.
3. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited, as well as any form of drugs that you are not under a doctor's prescription to take. Firearms of any kind are also prohibited.
4. Since this is a family activity, camping is with family members, not by units. Units can camp near each other, if desired.
5. A Trading Post will be opened to sell pizza and drinks Friday evening.
6. Campfire starts at 8 p.m.
7. First Aid is available in the Trading Post area.
8. NO OPEN FIRES!
9. Remember A Scout Is Clean. Please pick up all litter that you bring and take it with you. A bag is provided with your breakfast for your trash.
10. Scout patches for the campout may be picked up upon check-in.
11. Please refrain from smoking or vaping while at this Cub Scout event.
12. No camping is allowed under the aircraft. The Memorial Grounds open field fits all camping families.
13. Please do not leave your Cub Scout unattended or allow them to climb on displays while at the park.
14. **LOST & FOUND** (Children, Adults and other items of value will be maintained at the Trading Post.)
15. No pets are allowed at BSA events.
